Spring 2015 Rally – Sunday May 31st.

In keeping with the last four CVR rallies that have rotated through the Northeastern, Southeastern, Southwestern and Northwestern parts of Connecticut, the Spring 2015 rally will be held back in the Northeastern quadrant. The route is now set for this rally. It is about a 45 mile loop through South Windsor, East Windsor, Somers and Ellington that should take everyone about 2 hours of driving time to complete. There will be 5 check points at which each team will receive a playing card to compete for the best poker hand at the finishing venue. One or more of the legs between the checkpoints will be gimmicked, and most of the gimmicks will be sign reading and interpretation. The gimmicked legs will have coursemarkers on them that teams will record on their scoresheets for good points or bad points depending on where they were seen. Some of the coursemarkers will have supplemental instructions keyed to them that will get you back on the main rally route – whether you got off the route for a good reason, or a bad reason. This rally will not be a speed or time/speed/distance event, as everyone will be given a reasonable amount of time to finish the rally at their own pace.

The starting place will be the Dunkin Donuts at the corner of Route 5 and Pleasant Valley Road in South Windsor, and the finishing restaurant will be the Nutmeg Restaurant on Route 5 in East Windsor. There will be a full Sunday brunch waiting for participants at the Nutmeg with complete breakfast, luncheon items, sweets and appropriate adult beverages (approximately \$30 pp – Dutch treat). Registration will open at 8:00 AM and the first car should go off shortly after 9:00 AM.

CVR logo participation gifts will be given to each rally participant and prizes will be awarded for winners of both the poker run and gimmicked rally. General instructions will be available a couple of weeks before the rally and will be emailed out to all registrants.

The rally will be rain or shine, and if you don't want to bring your Porsche because of inclement weather, we will let you complete in the family truckster. The rallyist of the year will be recognized at the November annual meeting/banquet this year and since there will only be two rallies in 2015 (Spring and Fall), you need to come and run the rally even if it rains.

This should be a great rally, and a little shorter than our most recent rallies ... i.e., minimal concentration time. The brunch opens at 10:00, so if you want to end your rally run early and just head to the brunch with the rest of the CVR rallyists, that's OK.
