There will be a rest stop less than an hour into the drive. Distance to Vanilla Bean is about 52 miles; total distance including the return run is about 100 miles.</p> <p>This is a great spring warm up run, winding thru Stonington on Pequot Trail, thru the Pachaug State Forest area on Rte. 49, then following Rte. 169 to Pomfret for a great lunch at the Bean. Return route will wind south on Rtes. 198, 97, 87, and 163, and finish at the Salem Valley Farms for an ice cream dessert.</p> <p>Starting point will be Starbucks, 12 Coogan Blvd #1, Mystic, CT. From I-95, take Exit 90 onto Rte. 27 South, turn left at first light on Coogan Blvd. (towards Mystic Aquarium). In 0.2 miles, turn right on Clara Drive and right into the Starbucks Plaza. Coffee, bathrooms and gas within a 1/4 mile. We will stop for lunch at the Vanilla Bean café in Pomfret, CT, each individual is responsible for paying for their lunch.</p>

There will be rest stop about an hour into the drive. Distance to the lunch stop is about 80 miles; total distance including the return run is about 112 miles.</p> <p>The Porsche GTS Community web site offers owner submitted great drives from all over the world. I've combined a couple GTS owner submissions into this longer than usual run. Our drive will take us from the coast at Mystic up through eastern CT and into northwestern RI. We will do a loop around the Scituate Reservoir, stop for lunch on the way back at Mr. Z's Pizza in Plainfield, and finish at an ice cream shop in Ledyard, CT.</p> <p>Starting point will be Starbucks, 12 Coogan Blvd #1, Mystic, CT. From I-95, take Exit 90 onto Rte. 27 South, turn left at the first light on Coogan Blvd. (towards Mystic Aquarium). In 0.2 miles, turn right on Clara Drive and right into the Starbucks Plaza. Coffee, bathrooms, and gas within a 1/4 mile. We will stop for lunch at Mr. Z's Pizza, each individual is responsible for paying for their lunch. <p>August 20, 2016</p>	<p>Ocean Cliff Resort Coffee Run by Tim Anderson</p> <p>Most of our runs head inland for twisty forest roads, but this is a coastal run up to Newport, RI with some outstanding vistas to enjoy along the way. Starting in Mystic, CT, we'll wind thru some back roads in Stonington then head south to US-1 for a run up the coast of Rhode Island. We'll detour off US-1 in Narragansett to get closer to the shore and an optional stop at the Black Point Trailhead, where a short hike from the parking lot leads to a breezy, rocky overlook of Narragansett Bay. In Newport, we'll go past a few mansions and do a scenic loop around the southern shore, ending up at the Ocean Cliff Resort for lunch in the Safari Room. There is no return route planned as folks may decide to spend some time checking out other Newport attractions and return at their leisure. There will be a rest stop about an hour into the drive at mile 36. Total distance to lunch stop is about 60 miles.</p> <p>Meet between 8:30 and 9:00 AM for coffee, drivers meeting at 9:00, on the road at 9:15.
