The Lime Rock Historic Festival — a new title for 2010. Reflecting the long history of the event, this year will see its 28th consecutive running. The 2010 Historic Festival will feature classes of cars from the pre-war era, sports racing cars of the fabulous '50s and the awesome Le Mans racers of the '70s.

The Lime Rock Team under Chairman Murray Smith has planned an exciting weekend of automotive activities on and off the celebrated racetrack, situated in the scenic surroundings of the Berkshire Hills. The Festival will celebrate the Fiat family of great marques. Ferrari, Lancia, Maserati, Fiat; with a special tribute to the 100th anniversary of Alfa Romeo. The organizers expect significant examples of famous cars from these distinguished manufacturers to be on display at the event, both on and off the Lime Rock circuit.

On track activities, sanctioned by the VSCCA, will feature eight race groups, including Pre-War,

The Lime Rock Historic Festival — Planning Your Weekend

The Festival is a four-day event, running from Friday, September 3 through Monday, September 6. There are a number of options for club participation.

Admission: Car club prices, including parking, are as follows: Weekend advance purchase is: \$80/person; Saturday and Monday are \$35/person. Sunday in the Park car show is \$20/person or \$25/person at the gate. There is no entry fee to

show your car. Note: club organizers will receive two free weekend passes and a Historic Festival polo shirt.



Corrals: Located in the infield, depending on the number of cars, with a minimum of 25 cars required for a corral position.

Parade Laps: Saturday or Monday. Open to clubs with 25 or more cars that organize a corral or purchase a hospitality package.

NOTE: Because of time limits on the track, only the first 50 cars in each paddock will be eligible for parade laps.
